## **Code of conduct for students**

The students of Santipur College are expected to uphold the values of discipline, respect, and responsibility both within and outside the campus. Every student is a representative of the institution, and therefore must conduct themselves in a manner that reflects the dignity of the College.

### **1. General Discipline**

- Students must maintain discipline, decorum, and courtesy in the classroom, library, laboratory, campus, and during all college events.
- Attendance and punctuality are mandatory. A minimum percentage of attendance (as per University/UGC norms) is required to appear for examinations.
- Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in classrooms, library, and during academic activities unless permitted by the teacher.

### **2. Academic Integrity**

- Students must complete assignments, projects, and examinations with honesty and sincerity.
- Plagiarism, cheating, or use of unfair means in any form will invite disciplinary action.
- Respect for teachers and cooperation in the teaching-learning process is compulsory.

### **3. Respectful Behaviour**

- Every student must treat teachers, non-teaching staff, fellow students, and visitors with respect.
- Any form of harassment, discrimination, ragging, bullying, or violence is strictly prohibited and punishable under institutional and legal provisions.
- Students must maintain gender sensitivity and inclusive behaviour at all times.

### **4. Dress and Identity**

- Students should be decently dressed on campus.
- Identity Cards issued by the College must be carried at all times and produced when required.

## **5. Campus Property and Cleanliness**

- Students must protect and preserve college property, infrastructure, and resources. Any damage or defacement will be considered a serious offence.
- Cleanliness of classrooms, corridors, common areas, and the campus must be maintained. Use of plastic and littering is discouraged.
